12/14	Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Day and Davis.
13/14	To receive declarations of interest on items on the agenda. None
14/14	The minutes of the meeting held on 16th January 2014 were agreed as a correct record.
15/14	Matters arising. None
	Public Adjournment. Members of the public asking questions on the agenda should give their name and address None in attendance
16/14	Members voted to co-opt Martin Rafferty onto the committee.
17/14	Discuss storage of caravan and Christmas float. The clerk reported she had been asking around to see if any of the local farmers had space, she has also written to Mr Brand and Andy Birkett HB Carnival Committee but had not yet received a response. Cllr Sargent is also talking to local farmers and Paul Parker said his Mum would have space on her drive for one of the vehicles. Cllr Taylor was willing to have the float under her car port if there was space. Martin said the roof of the float could be altered and made up with scaffold poles in order that it could be removed for storage. The clerk pointed out that when in use that would mean removing it each time it comes back, if stored at Cllr Taylors. This will be discussed again at the next meeting.
18/14	To discuss fun day; Cllr Nicholson will contact the Royal Sussex and get numbers in order to work out the cost for their attendance. Edwards Leisure, Caribbean food, scouts, karate, dog show, ice cream van, G&S Catapults, Mr Miles, Ring the bell have confirmed. Miss Herne Bay is also booked to attend. The face painters are booked, as are GoKart Party and Pip the Clown. We will again get £100 towards PA from Serco. Kent Firefit unable to confirm until after beginning of April. There is a problem however and that is HB Promo team are hosting a big event in Herne Bay on the same day. They have an airshow planned along with other events in Herne Bay. After discussion it was decided that changing the fun day date was not an option and we have to hope that numbers will not be affected. Cllr Nicholson will purchase a shield for the challenge and 6 organisations will be asked to take part. Fun day forms have gone to CCC.
