Cllr Saunders chaired the meeting in Cllr Taylors absence.

01/18	Apologies for absence. Cllr Taylor, who is moving tomorrow.
02/18	To receive declarations of interest on items on the agenda. None.
03/18	The minutes of the meeting held on 23rd November 2017, were agreed as a correct record.
04/18	Matters arising. None
	Public Adjournment. Members of the public asking questions on the agenda should give their name and address None
05/18	To discuss Fun Day progress. The clerk reported that Car show applications are coming in. she asked if members thought that stall fees should rise this year. Members agreed to leave the charity and local organisation prices the same, but the commercial ones should pay more. A 3 x 3 will be £40 and 6 x 3 £80 and so on. The Go Karts and Mini Quads will be charged a set fee for both. Cllr Saunders said the brass band were definite, there had been some changes regarding the Sea Cadets but he hoped the problems that they have currently will be ironed out by then. There will be a Tai Chi display hopefully with audience participation and Circle Dance, the races will go ahead as usual, if there is a Ceroc dance group using the Herne Centre they could be asked to attend. The clerk will purchase a couple more Space Hoppers. Fire Brigade will be invited. There is someone who lives in Lower Herne Rd who does Balloon Modelling Cllr Davison will get details. The dog show and Pony Rides are sorted. Cllr Harvey will be asked to look at the signs for the Fun Day and Garden Safari so the dates can be changed in plenty of time. Cllr Sargent is willing to have one put up in his garden and Cllr White said the same. One could also be placed on the back of the noticeboard in Streetfield, Cllr Sargent will take a look.

The clerk reported that there had been a good meeting with those opening their gardens on Saturday, so far 18 including schools, church, allotments and St Martins, with another 2 or 3 possible. Cllr Davis has done flyers and posters and the clerk will get them out to those who want them as soon as possible. It is hoped that Vincents will once again sponsor the programmes. Cllr Davis is advertising the event on the Open Gardens web site.

The party this year will be held in the Herne Centre on 8 th December and it was agreed that the same entertainer would be booked and also Shout would be asked to attend again. The Float dates were also discussed and it was agreed the float would go out on 22 nd and 23 rd December. Paul Parker will be informed.
