11/08	Election of Chairman. Cllr Taylor was elected as chairman and Cllr Saunders as Vice Chairman.
12/18	Apologies for absence received from Cllr Sargent and Paul Parker.
13/18	To receive declarations of interest on items on the agenda. None
14/18	The minutes of the meeting held on 15th March 2018 were agreed as a correct record.
15/18	Matters arising. The clerk reported that Paul Parker might not be able to attend the Children's Christmas Party or Float but he can do the Fun Day. The date is confirmed for 20 th October for a Race Night.

16/18	To discuss Fun Day progress. Cllr Davis said she had plenty of prizes for the races but still needed to look at tombola prizes. The clerk reported that she had not had many stalls confirm yet. Hopefully two face painters had been secured and a couple of food stalls had been contacted. The scouts will be attending. Cllr Saunders reported that the Faversham Brass Band were OK and also Tai Chi but no Karate and no Sea Cadets. Cllr Davis will ask Sophies Dance School if they would like to do a demonstration and there will also be a Circle Dance Demo. James from Community Centre has offered a couple of youth workers to help with the races. Everything is organised for the Dog show. Cllrs O'Donnell and Knight will be asked if they can try and get some prizes for the tombola. Cllrs Blatherwick and White will not be able to attend as they are away. Chairs from Strode can be collected during the morning. Rotary will supply people to look after the car park. There will be two wardens and Dan the highway steward, who will be in charge of the gate.
