

HERNE & BROOMFIELD PARISH COUNCIL

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Minutes of the **Extra-Ordinary Parish Council Meeting** of Herne & Broomfield Parish Council held at Herne Mill, Wootton Room, on Thursday 23rd February at 7.30pm, for the purpose of transacting the following business.

Present: Cllr Day, Cllr Blatherwick, Cllr Tracey Jones, Cllr Robert Jones, Cllr Harvey, Cllr Breal, Cllr Sargent, Cllr Tobin, Cllr Nicholson, Cllr Taylor, Cllr Hobbs and Cllr Moore.

047/12 To receive apologies for absence and approve reasons. Cllr Davis who is visiting family.

048/12 To receive declarations of interest on items on Agenda. Cllr Day who is a member of the HAT committee.

049/12 To discuss the request to organise a walk for those who wish to show their dissatisfaction at the proposal by Tesco to take over the Upper Red Lion on 4th March. Cllr Tracey Jones suggested that residents with placards lining the route and asking motorists to hoot if they support, could have been an alternative to the procession. Cllr Day told members he thought that as HAT had made the decision to have a procession it would be difficult to change at this stage. It was explained that due to the nature of the event it would be classed as a procession, this meant that it did not have to be covered by the Public Order Act and would come under the Town & Police Clauses Act 1847 S21.

Members agreed that this event would be run by the parish council. HAT would be asked to help with marshals on the day. Cllr Taylor and her daughter will be the designated 1st Aiders. The council also approved the additional cost of £53 for the insurance. The clerk will request Hi Vis jackets and radios from CCC. Advance warning signs for the road closure will go up over the weekend.
